



LOCAL SYSTEMS APPROACH


The Activity prioritizes and enhances strengths in each partner municipality and in the local system. The local systems approach is grounded in the following key characteristics:



HLG coordinates with the local governments and/or services providers as well as Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) to develop customized Municipal Action Plans (MAPs).







HLG supports municipalities with migration policy development, assisting immigrant returnee centers, and responding to the needs of returnees and internally displaced persons. HLG also strengthens public awareness of migration, its risks, human rights, and other topics. Approach addresses Gender-Based Violence (GBV), gender equality, and LGBTQI+ by building the capacity of vulnerable groups to advocate and reduce gaps. Building leadership in service planning, resource allocation, and oversight to catalyze local actions.
